The Pastor's Pen. What is our response to a Faithful God?

Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: Come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; We are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, And into his courts with praise: Be thankful unto him. And bless his name. For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; And his truth endureth to all generations. Psalm 100:1-5 KJV.

As we celebrate the month of prayer here at Brookland Baptist Church along with the memory of last month's celebration of our Pastor's 50th anniversary, we know without reservation that we have so much to be thankful for! Psalm 100 gives us guidance and direction on how a grateful heart can give thanks to God and why we should. During the month of November, we see the season changing and this is the time that emotions also begin to shift to goodwill and thankful thoughts of gratitude as we ponder on family, friends, and loved ones near and far. This year, because of the pandemic and other unforeseen circumstances, we have suffered great loss. There have been some painful moments where we have been challenged and without Holy Spirit hugging our hearts, and holding our hands, it would have been unbearable, yet our testimony is "God has always answered our prayers of provision and protection"! Let's just keep it 100...The truth that we can all proclaim is that, even in the midst of trying times and agonizing predicaments...God is "Faithful", and we are grateful.

Comparatively, during this season of change, I would ask that we consider the word "Thanksgiving", this compound word, "Thanks" which denotes an expression or acknowledgment of appreciation or gratitude, and "Giving", an action word, an adjective, which means, to give someone something, a responsibility, or service. My brothers and sisters in Christ, I would like to ask you a very important question, when you think about all that God has done for you and your family; children, grandchildren, parent(s), friends, finances, homes, and health, etc.

What is your response to a Faithful God? You guessed it...Thanksgiving!

Psalm 100:4 says "Enter into his gates with thanksgiving and into his courts with praise; be thankful unto him and bless his name" but the first three (3) verses tell us to make a joyful noise and serve him because we are his sheep and that is important too!

There are so many implications from this Psalm but here is the challenge that I would like to make as we all move into this new season of prayer, praise, and thanksgiving. In celebration of God's faithfulness in answering our prayers and remaining faithful to us in the middle of a pandemic, we should respond accordingly. Let us make a joyful noise, enter into His gates with thanksgiving and then go out and serve (bless His name)! God has proven Himself over the last couple of years that He is capable of taking care of us. Last month, we celebrated our Pastor's 50th anniversary of leadership and pastoral care of over tens of thousands of members. He has been our shepherd and we have been asked to follow him like sheep. If God has been taking care of our Pastor, will He do likewise for us? As we move into this new season, we all should consider doing two things:

(1). Make a "joyful noise" by upgrading our pray life and praise, purposefully! God deserves that right? He has great





plans for His people in this season. Our pastor told us that "If we are still breathing, God has a plan for our lives." We will hear God speak in purposeful times of prayer and praise. God desires to hear us talking with Him, giving Him the thanks and gratitude that He deserves. He inhabits the praises of His beloved. (Psalm 22:3). I cannot imagine loving someone and never telling them and others how much I appreciate them. People need to hear our testimony and the good news of Jesus Christ. They will be saved because we shared our praise! (Rev.12:11).

The second consideration or challenge is found in verses 4 and 5. As we are approaching a new season, the passion of Christ, and a new year, we should not get complacent on God's commandments and His expectations from us as His children. (v.3). The psalmist admonishes us to, "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise and be thankful unto Him and bless His name." There is a charge for us to enter, be thankful, praise, and bless God. The latter (bless) calls for a personal sacrifice. To "bless" means to fill with benefits, or in another sense, the word means to "praise," as if to fill with honor and good words. It is also seen throughout Scripture as an act of physical service and sacrifice or acts of worship.





(2). "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise..." Here it is, as we are approaching this new season and New Year, things are changing. We must remember that God has proven Himself faithful to us for over two years in this global pandemic. The second consideration requires a certain level of trust, and you definitely have to get in the prayer room to hear God. It means considering returning to worship service to give thanks and praise to God. It is time for believers to "consider" coming out of isolation and making a joyful noise of praise and thanksgiving to the God of our salvation. Did you know that it is thought by biblical scholars that the children of Israel sang or chanted Psalm 100 as they entered the temple or began



their worship services?¹ How awesome is that? This psalm was used to bless the Lord and praise His name with other believers in the house of the Lord to corporately "give" Him "thanks". I know we have been making a joyful noise in our private time with God, now it is time to "consider" entering the house of the Lord. I am going to do it; I pray you will too.

In closing, as you imagine the season changing and how thankful you are to God, think about this. What God said to us in 2019, 2020, and 2021 may not be what He is saying for the upcoming New Year, inquire of the Lord. God is calling His people to a closer walk into His "gates" and "courts." This represents our private and public sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving.

It is time for non-believers to see our faith and trust in God "shift and change"! The final verse of Psalm 100:5 tells us why we should consider all of this... "For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting: And his truth endureth to all generations." Our youth and teens are looking at us, let us make sure we are giving them good examples to model.

As we celebrate a new season of prayer and gratefulness, what will our response be to a Faithful Loving God? I pray it is a return to the house of the Lord to give Him prayer, praise, and thanksgiving because He is good, and He deserves it!

May God bless you to hear His heart and serve His people for Jesus is soon to return. Happy Thanksgiving to you all.




