

his year marks 28 years that The Brookland Foundation, the community outreach arm of the Brookland Church, has worked to improve the lives of people by developing and promoting efforts to enhance the lives of low-to-moderate income residents of the Midlands of South Carolina. For nearly three decades, our supporters, board members, staff and volunteers have consistently risen to the occasion by working together to make life better for our neighbors and we couldn't be more proud of what we have been able to accomplish together.

Although we have accomplished much through our Tutorial, Homeless Outreach, Health and Wellness, and HIV/AIDS programs there is more work to be done. All that we have experienced over the last three years has presented us with new opportunities and a unique set of challenges that have served as a notice of the call for us to do more. Though daunting tasks lie ahead of us, we hope that we can count on your continued financial support, your ideas and feedback, and the lending of your time and talents to enable us to continue making lasting change in our community. Your support, especially during one of the toughest times we have known, is confirmation that together we can achieve whatever we set out to accomplish.

You have made it possible for us to make life better for our neighbors when our community needed us most. Your commitment to supporting the efforts of The Brookland Foundation reminds us that "Moving Mountains for Community" is more than a marketing proposition. It is more than just an empty motto that takes up cozy residence on our letterhead, t-shirts, and website. It is more than just an idea of who we aim to be or what we wish we could accomplish. The phrase, "Moving Mountains for Community" is in our DNA. It serves as our guiding light in the decisions we make in exercising good stewardship of your gifts, in choosing the partners we work with, and how we help the people who need us most. "Moving Mountains for Community" speaks to who The Brookland Foundation is at our very core. It is represented in the steps we take each day toward creating sustainable change and having a lasting impact.

In early 2020, as we began to learn how to navigate the COVID-19 global pandemic and the "new normal," the need for community outreach intensified. We were faced with the task of tackling new challenges presented by the pandemic while continuing to fulfill the promise of our daily work in closing the gap in health disparities, combating homelessness, providing emergency financial assistance to families in need, and ending hunger in The Midlands. Though we faced a new brand of adversity, Mountain Movers you stepped up to the plate and pitched in to help make things happen.

Here is how you helped us make a difference:

- You helped 20 homeless people secure permanent housing.
- You provided emergency financial assistance to 51 families.
- You distributed 635 homeless care packages.
- You served 45 people living with HIV.
- You provided 40 free sports physicals to low-income students.
- You served more than 350 families a month in our food bank.
- You provided over 60 hours of one-on-one virtual tutoring.
- You facilitated 168 hours of breast cancer support group sessions.

Our impact is evidence that your gifts and volunteerism make a difference and we solicit your continued support. On behalf of our Board Chair, Harry Thompson and the rest of The Brookland Foundation team, we offer you our sincerest appreciation.


