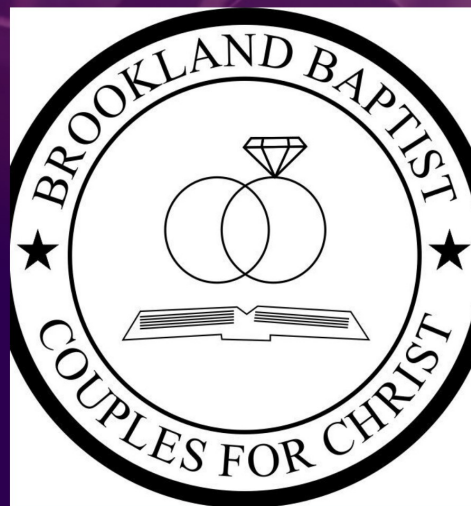

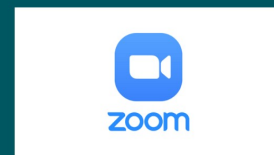

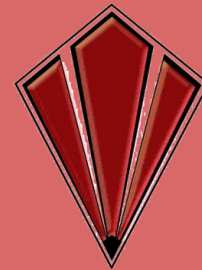

Four Good Friends: Mark 2:1-5 New International Version

¹A few days later, when Jesus again entered Capernaum, the people heard that he had come home. ²So many gathered that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. ³Some men came, bringing to him a paralytic, carried by four of them. ⁴Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus and, after digging through it, lowered the mat the paralyzed man was lying on. ⁵When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

My message this month is directed towards our children who find themselves going back to school and even those going back to college. Some of you might know that my dad is a criminal attorney. Since 1968, he has been defending the rights of men and women throughout this state. As a young man, I too thought that I wanted to be a lawyer, but the Lord changed my travel arrangements. But as a young boy I would crawl between my parents in their bedroom and talk to my daddy about his cases. As I grew up to be a teenager, I can remember that my daddy would always relate to me stories about his clients who had been charged with crimes for simply being in the wrong place at the wrong time. He would continuously tell me Chris, be careful who you hang around. Chris, be careful where you go, be careful who you call your friends. I come to you today by way of this letter to remind you to make sure you are choosing the right friends to hang around and associate yourself with this year.

In this story in the book of Mark we find FOUR GOOD FRIENDS!!! Like hundreds of others they heard that Jesus was in town. They heard that he was in a house in the hood and they thought it was necessary to go and see this man whom some say had miraculous power. So when they heard that Jesus was near they put their feet in the dusty trails and made their way to see Jesus. So here they are journeying to see Jesus and when they get near the house they see the mob of people. Can't you imagine invalids from all over Judea were there. The sick, the psychotic, the downtrodden, the lame, the oppressed had marched and crawled from all over the region to see this doctor who specialized in healing. When they get there they find themselves in the back of the line. The crowds moved an inch at a time. You would think they were going to see Beyonce' or Jay-Z. They become dispossessed by how long it took the line to grow shorter. So one of them makes a motion that all of them understood. One of the four said lets GO UP! They raise the man on top of the roof and began pulling the roof apart so that they might lower the man into the house so that Jesus might heal him. Jesus saw three things in the four friends and I pray you will find these same attributes in your friends.

Number one they were simply **FRIENDLY**. They were kind enough to help a person in need. It has been said to gain a friend you must first show yourself friendly. Its four of them, because a bed has four sides. The man had all he needed because he had four good friends. Make sure your friends add value to your life.

Secondly, they were **FOCUSED**. They did not let the crowds stop them from getting their friend to his destination. Likewise you need to be focused solely on your school work. Yes, sports and extracurricular activities are important but you go to school to pass this grade and make it to the next level and eventually **GRADUATE**.

Your focus should not be on how many followers you have and how many likes you get on Instagram. Your focus needs to be on a **TELEGRAM** (that's old school DM) from a college that says you are accepted or a job that has been offered to you.

And third and finally, they were **FAITHFUL**. If you look at the text what Jesus sees first is not the man coming through the roof. He doesn't even see the bed or the man. What he sees is the **FAITH** of the **FOUR FRIENDS**. Do your friends have faith? Are your friends believers? Do your friends go to church? Have you invited your friends to church? For birds of a feather flock together and if you show me your friends I will see who you are.

So make sure you hang around and associate with persons who are nice and kind, focused on their futures, and have faith in Jesus Christ. And if they don't, Be a **GOOD FRIEND** and introduce them to the best friend you can ever have.

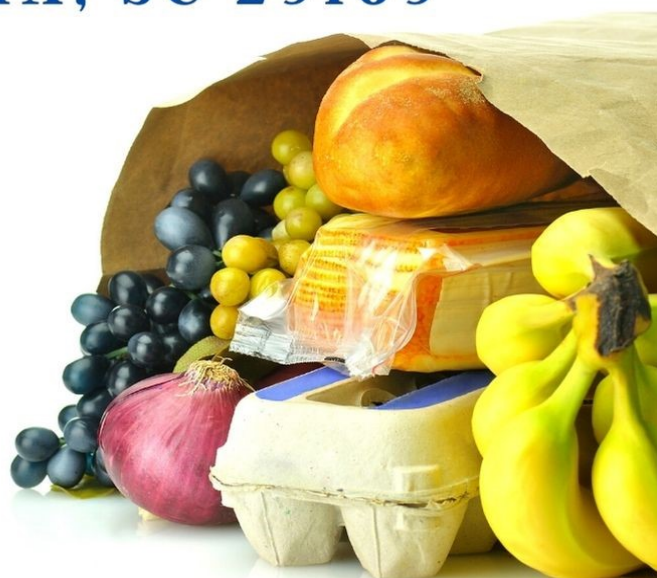
