Beginning in the late 19th century, besides women working for broad-based economic and political equality and for social reforms, women sought to change voting laws to allow them to vote.

After a hard-fought series of votes in the U.S. Congress and in state legislatures, the Nineteenth Amendment became a part of the U.S. Constitution on August 18, 1920. It states, "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex."



That moment was the culmination of a long struggle, the themes of which are timely – voting rights, women's rights. So let us celebrate this right and know that our vote counts.

I encourage you to reach out to sisters everywhere; in your church, community, and work place to remember that we can make a difference. We are paving the way for a brighter future for our youth when we exercise this right. Let's harness the energy and excitement of the women suffrage to improve and expand voting rights for all.

SISTERS LEARN TIPS FOR PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY


