Lastly, if you have not already signed up to receive the electronic, full-color version of The

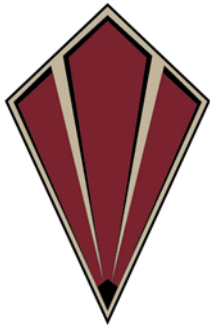

Mark your calendars for College Day, Sunday, September 15th at both worship services. You will be in for a special treat from our young people.

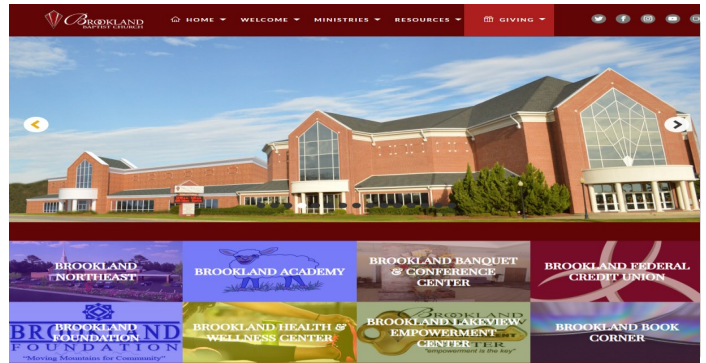

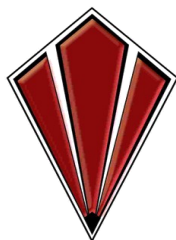

MID-YEAR REPORT 2019

To the faithful believers who honor the faith in the family and fellowship of the Brookland Baptist Church. Grace be unto you and peace from God, our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. We are pleased to report to you the uncommon favor God has bestowed upon Brookland's Ministry. Last year, 2018, was the most difficult and painfully testing year I can recall in recent memory. Strength and sustenance would come every Sunday morning when I ascended the sacred desk of God's pulpit and declared "*the joy of the Lord is ours.*" As the year concluded, God began to reward our faithfulness in greater measure.

On Friday, December 14th, you and I were awarded an Honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from Columbia International University. Three (3) days later, we were awarded an Honorary Doctor of Public Service degree from the University of South Carolina. You **AND I**, as I made known at each institution, received those degrees together as a **Pastor** and **People** in service to humankind. **I** am because **WE** are. Two (2) Honorary Doctorate degrees in three (3) days is what we call uncommon favor. Far more importantly, Brookland has stretched out in the faith and has begun to wade into deeper spiritual waters of the Christian religion.

I am also growing in excitement over the construction of our Christian Learning Center. Everything is progressing on schedule. The demolition activities are over. The spread and isolated footings have been poured. The plumbing slab rough-in work for the support wing is finished. All civil infrastructure, which includes the new sanitary service line, water line diversion, and stormwater/roof drainage systems are complete. The foundation has been well-laid, and we are now in position for structural steel installation. The roofing will be up and finished by mid-August. Our pryer is for construction to be completed in the Spring of 2020.

I cannot begin to tell you how absolutely necessary it is for a Christian Learning Center. Frederick Douglas said, "It is easier to build strong children than to repair broken men." Forces of oppression are still trying to suppress the hopes and dreams and ambitions of our young people. If you don't believe it is so **PLEASE** take the time and watch the four (4) part series of "**When They See Us.**" This movie portrays the evil agenda of an evil people who wrongfully incarcerated five (5) teenage boys who came to be known as the "**Central Park 5.**" Without any evidence, and no witnesses or DNA, in 1989, these young boys were sentenced to 5-13 years in prison for a crime they did not commit.

We need a weekday program to further impress and imprint upon the minds and hearts of our youth and teens of who we are as African-Americans. We need programs that will enlighten, encourage, and empower character and leadership in our young people. Every American citizen needs to see the movie – "**When They See Us.**" James Baldwin said, "For these are all our children. We will all profit by or pay for whatever they become."

There are no words to express my gratitude for how you have responded to our Capital Campaign Drive. Never before have we been able to raise \$1 million in any building project Brookland has had. However, because you believe in the building assignment, God has given us to complete the Master's Plan on the West Campus, to this date, we have raised over \$1.62 million. We only need about \$380,000 to reach our goal and do what many said we could not do. Some of

my pastoral colleagues told me, “Jack, you can’t get that much money out of Black folks. They’ve got too many big car loans, expensive jewelry and name-brand clothes around their backs to pay for. After giving God His tithes, they are through.” Well, the devil is a liar. I thank you for silencing the skeptics, dismissing the critics and telling the devil where to go. **We have done well!**

A total of seven hundred and forty-five (745) persons and families have pledged which represent the 2000 believers for which we have been praying. Four hundred and twenty-five (425) have completed their pledges. We encourage the three hundred and twenty (320) persons who have not completed their pledge to do so before construction is completed.

I am asking all who have joined Brookland over the past two (2) years to pledge your faithfulness to the Christian Learning Center. The levels of giving are:

DIAMOND	\$20,000 and above
PLATINUM	\$10,000 - \$19,999
GOLD	\$ 5,000 - \$ 9,999
SILVER	\$ 2,000 - \$ 4,999
BRONZE	\$ 1,000 - \$ 1,999

Pledge envelopes are located on Sundays in the back of the pews. Your name will be prominently displayed and listed on a Wall of Faith plaque as one who invested in the next generation. As a member of Brookland, you would certainly want your name listed on the Wall of Faith. You would want your grandchildren, ten (10) years from now, to see your name listed in support of “God’s plan to prosper you and not to harm you; to give you hope and a future” (Jeremiah 29:11). If you have any questions, you may call your deacon who will be glad to help you.

If you have already completed your pledge, and God has blessed you in greater measure, please consider increasing your pledge. With your gracious and generous support, I have every confidence that we will be able to make a significant impact on the lives of our young people for generations to come.

After forty-eight (48) years in pastoral ministry, I am happier and more excited than I have ever been. “What God has planned for people who love Him is more than eyes have seen or ears have heard. It has never entered our minds.” (I Corinthians 2:9 – Contemporary English Bible CEB)

Thank you for your faithful obedience to God’s Word. Saying “thank-you” seems so small compared to all you have done, but it comes from the far reaches of my heart. I love you all and pray for the favor of God to abide with you.

- ◆ Infant dedications are designed for children 6-18 months old
- ◆ Parents are to complete one session of Parenting University prior to the dedication (Single parents must complete a counseling session with the Pastor in addition to Parenting University)
- ◆ There is no fee associated with Infant Dedication.
- ◆ Because of the limited number of spaces, preference is given to Brookland Members.

- ◆ Brookland offers the use of our sanctuary to members and non-members so please specify
- ◆ Members pay a nominal fee to include Audio visual support and clean up (for weddings purposes, the definition of a member pertains to the Bride or Groom to not include any member of the immediate family)
- ◆ Non-members pay a fee to utilize the sanctuary in addition to member fees
- ◆ A non-refundable security deposit is required to book the date
- ◆ Members may request a Brookland minister to perform the ceremony or have the option to utilize outside clergy

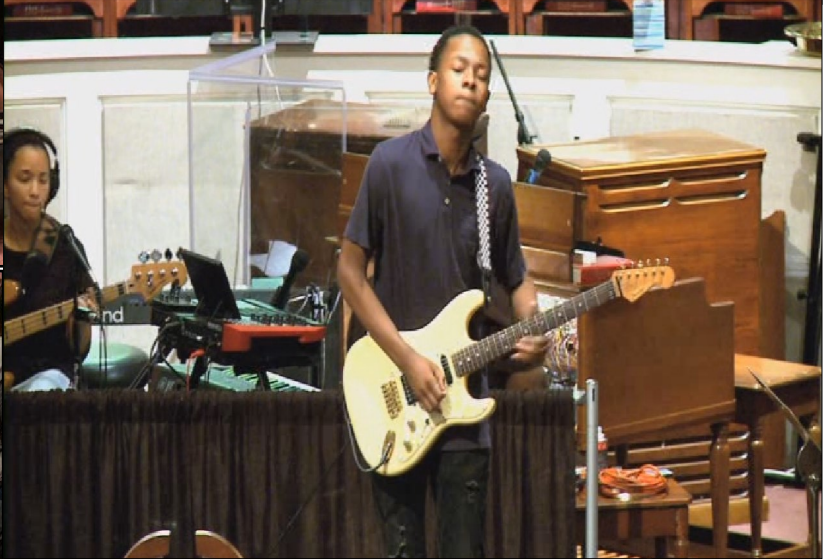
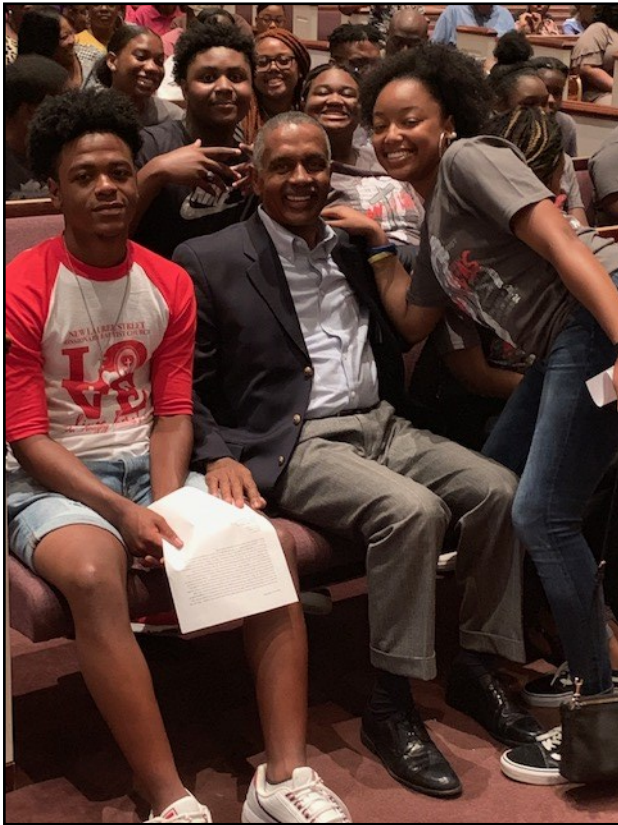

Celebrating Breast Cancer Survivors

The Brookland Foundation is a community based non-profit organization established in 1994 to extend outreach to the greater Columbia community. Our mission is to improve the lives of people by developing and promoting efforts to enhance their spiritual, emotional, physical, social and economic well being.

The Color Pink Breast Cancer Awareness Gala is a special event sponsored by the **Brookland Foundation’s Health and Wellness Program**. The American Cancer Society has reported breast cancer as the most commonly diagnosed cancer and the second leading cause of cancer death among women in the United States. The purpose for this event is to raise community awareness concerning breast cancer with an emphasis on prevention and early detection. Funds raised provide scholarships for breast cancer screenings (mammograms) for the uninsured and under-insured and to provide education and awareness to the general public on breast cancer and support other Brookland Foundation program initiatives.

In 2008 the Health and Wellness program was approached by Mrs. Sandra Golden-Brown with a request for assistance to help her celebrate her 20th year as a breast cancer survivor. That meeting lead to the first Color Pink Awareness Breast Cancer Gala. Little did we know that this program would continue and grow over the next eleven years to help an average of 20 women annually obtain mammograms, create a breast cancer support group, and provide breast cancer awareness to more than 300 people each year. This year we are especially excited to celebrate Mrs Golden-Brown’s 30th year as a breast cancer survivor and inspiration for the Color Pink Initiatives.

We have been honored in the past to be joined by national recording artists such as Tamela Mann, Avery*Sunshine, Terence Young, Byron Cage, Dante Lewis and The Capitol City Chorale, as well as prominent actors such as Lynn Whitfield, Bern’Nadette Stanis, and Vanessa Bell Calloway. We are equally excited to bring in another awesome entertainer this year to help our survivors celebrate beating this terrible disease.

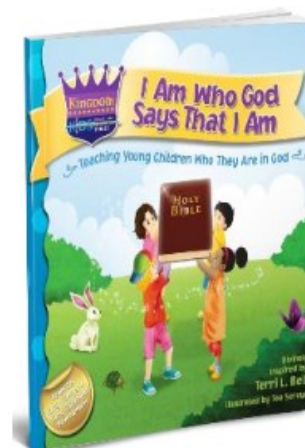
Financial Ministry Mega Forum will be held Saturday, November 23, 2019.

Our September Financial Empowerment Sunday



Deaconess Terri Bell, founder of Kingdom Kids Foundation, Owner of Divinely Inspired Publications and Author of “Kingdom Kids Books” will be featured on Financial Empowerment Sunday in September.

In celebration of the 5th anniversary of her first book, “*I Am Who God Says That I Am*”, Terri will be going on her 1st mission’s trip to Haiti to take the message of God’s love to children in an orphanage appropriately called, “Kingdom Kids Home”. The trip is scheduled for December 26th-January 3rd. She has been asked to translate her book into Haitian-Creole so that it can be used as a ministry tool to aid in teaching the children and spreading the gospel. Terri’s background as a Training & Curriculum Specialist will help assist the ministry staff with developing programming for the families and children in the community.



Terri uses Kingdom Kids books to equip, encourage and empower young children by teaching them who they were created to be in God. She will be launching the 2nd book in the series, “*I Can Be Who God Says I Can Be*”, in the New Year 2020. This book will introduce the nine Fruits of the Spirit while teaching children Godly character, and the 3rd book, “*I Will Have What God Says I Will Have*”, teaches young children how to have a “power-filled” relationship with Christ. It is schedule for release shortly afterwards. How awesome is that?



In partnership with Kingdom Kids Books, Kingdom Kids Foundation provides various support services and outreach to families and children with an emphasis on Early Literacy, Early Childhood and Christian Education. The foundation has a “**\$5 Hands Up for Haiti**” Christmas Campaign underway to provide Terri’s books to kids in the underserved communities of Bon Repos- Port Au Prince. All donations and proceeds from her book sales will go to fund the trip and share the gospel.

Terri is married to Deacon Frank Bell Jr. and she is a member of the Intercessory Prayer Ministry and the First Sunday Ensemble. She is also the facilitator for BBC Parent University’s “Power of a Praying Parent, Prayer Line. This group meets every Monday morning from 5:30am-6:00am. All parents are welcome to join. 😊

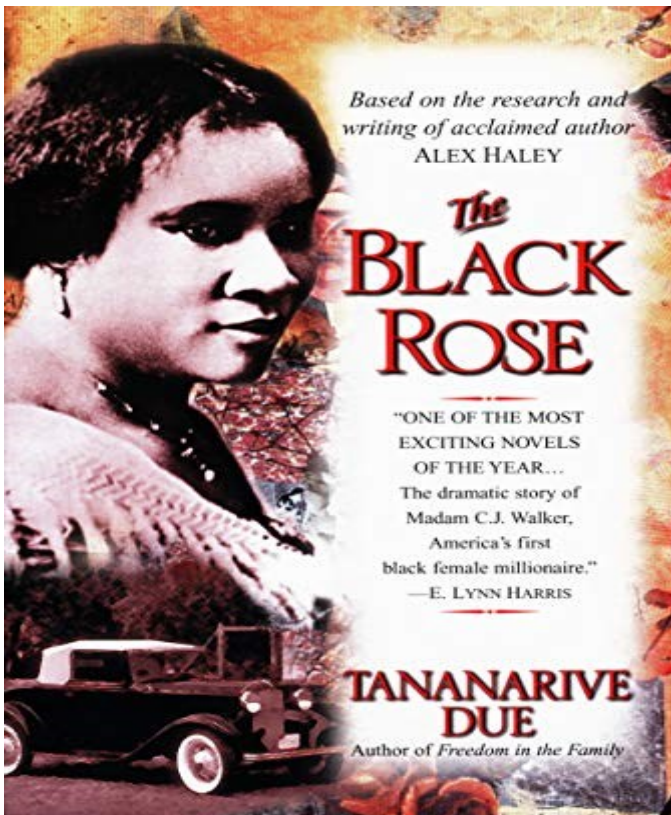

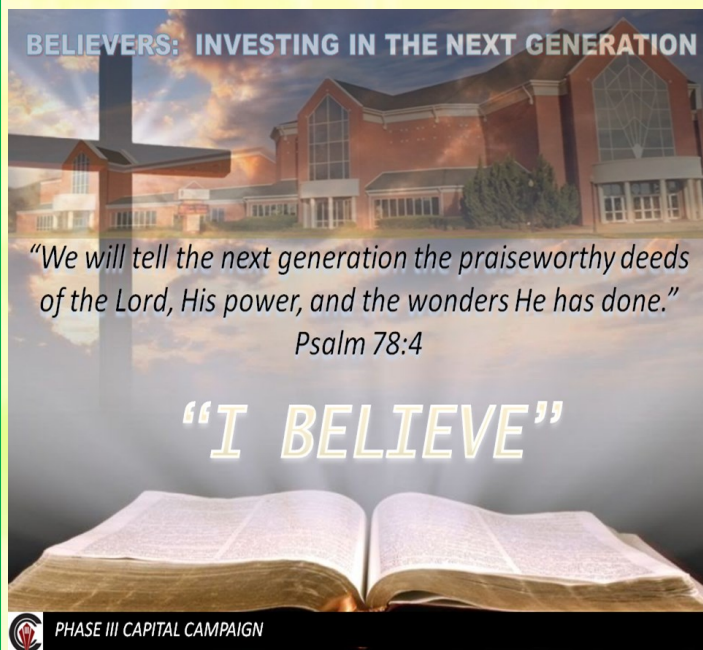
