The Brookland Senior Missionary Ministry is a vibrant group that operates with commitment, dedication, and service out of the gifts that God has given them.

It is a subsidiary of the Gethemane Woman's Baptist Association, which holds active membership and operates under the Baptist Educational and Missionary (E&M) Convention of South Carolina, which promotes the cause of Christ through Christian education and missionary work.

The mission of the Brookland Baptist Senior Ministry is to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ through evangelism, service and education. Its officers include Katherine Albert, president; Beatrice Stephens, vice- president; Vivian Neal, secretary; Shirley Kennedy, assistant secretary; Linda Coulter, corresponding secretary; Ruth Brown, treasurer; Susan Bennon, assistant treasurer; Louise Singleton, chaplain; Mazie Neal, assistant chaplain, and Beulah Ross, parliamentarian. The group continues its development and growth through various workshops, training sessions, and conferences including those sponsored by the Gethsemane Woman's Auxiliary and the State Women's Baptist E & M Convention.

Missionaries are actively involved in providing support to the following: Hannah House Project, Sistercare, Pruitt Nursing Home, Midlands Health and Rehabilitation Center, Brookland's Food Bank, and Reverend Lillie Burgess and her African Mission. Just recently the ministry made a commitment to partner with Brookland's Homeless Ministry, the Brookland Foundation's Health and Wellness Program, and BIRTHRIGHT of COLUMBIA, a non-profit initiative that serves pregnant girls and women. Due to Covid 19 restrictions, however, the missionaries no longer worships with clients at Midlands Health and Rehabilitation Center and Pruitt Nursing Home and no longer assists with repasts.

The group stands firmly on the foundation established by their founding sisters and devout leaders and aspires to continue in their amazing footsteps.

Meetings are held on Thursday following the second Sunday of each month at 5:00pm.

Some of its members share reflections and inspirations of their missionary journey.

Maggie Griffin

How long have you been a member of the ministry?

I joined the ministry in 2006 when I joined Brookland.

How did you get involved in the ministry?

My mother helped families, friends, and neighbors. I went with her to take food, medicine, and to do chores.

What is required of you as a member of the ministry?

The requirement of a member is to love what you do. I live by the motto: "I don't care if you have more than me in life. I don't want you to have any less than I have."

What is your vision of the ministry in the next 5 years?

My vision is that our ministry continues to do what God desires: to live, teach, love and be focused on the mission of the church.

Ethel Suber

How did you get involved in the ministry?

As a youth, I was always captivated by the wisdom and rich conversation of the elderly women in my neighborhood. It was always a privileged joy to be in their company, so much so that I began attending the missionary meetings with my mom at about the age of ten or eleven. I felt at home in such a loving, caring and serviceable environment, for these characteristics were already instilled within me by my parents.

What is required of you as a member of the ministry?

Finding ways to reach out in service in a loving and caring manner.

What is your vision of the ministry in the next 5 years?

In 5 years from now, word will travel around the country proclaiming the mighty works of the people of this Bethel Spot: This Brookland Baptist Senior Missionary Ministry.

Louise Singleton

How did you get involved in the ministry?

My life as a missionary started at a very young age. Growing up with my grandmother was the beginning of my missionary journey. She regularly sent me to take food to people in the neighborhood. It didn't matter who it was; you just had to have a need. I remember the time when she sent me to take food to the local funeral director who was ill. I was embarrassed because my mother cooked hot cakes and collard greens. The director was so grateful, and he raved about how good everything was every time we saw him. Mission does not have to be elaborate, just from the heart.

My mother was also a missionary at the Friendship Missionary Baptist Church, Leesville, SC. She had a very giving spirit. Every Wednesday on her day off, she prepared dinner for the mother of one of our own deceased member's mother. The running theme for most of their ministry was whatever we had to eat, there was always enough to share.

What is required of you as a member of the ministry?

God has given me the ministry of caring for children and older people. I opened my home to people in need, giving them some place to stay until they got on their feet. I formally became a missionary back in the seventies at Friendship Missionary Baptist Church. We met on the 3rd Sunday afternoon at the homes of the different members. We talked about the need for help in the community and proceeded to help in any way we could. We would assist as a group and individually. Mission work is all about doing God's work and a love for people. When I joined Brookland, I immediately joined the missionaries where I presently serve.

.What is your vision of the ministry in the next 5 years?

In the next five years, I would like to see the younger women become more active in mission. We as older women have tried to lay a foundation that can be passed on to the next generation. Could it be that as older women we are left here for such a time as this?

To me this scripture is the embodiment of mission: "For I was hungry, and you didn't feed me. I was thirsty, and you didn't give me a drink. I was a stranger, and you didn't invite me into your home. I was naked and you didn't give me clothing. I was sick and in prison and you didn't visit me. Then they replied, Lord, when did we ever see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison and not help you? And he answered, 'I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you are refusing to help me'." Matthew 25:42-45(NIV)

Pinkie Caldwell

How long have you been a member of the ministry?

I joined Brookland Missionary Senior Ministry in 1997.

How did you get involved in the ministry?

I have always been involved in the church. Baptist Training Union (BTU) is where I started, and my involvement grew from there.

What is required of you as a member of the ministry?

Daily praying to God for direction and serving His people.

What is your vision of the ministry in the next 5 years?

My vision is to have a large, faithful group that studies God's word, and do more group and individual projects.

Katherine (Kitty) Albert, President

How long have you been a member of the ministry?

I have been a member of the ministry since 2014.

How did you get involved in the ministry?

A friend of mine and a fellow church member of the ministry told me about it and made me very much aware of what they were doing in the church and the community. They were all positives. Having attended missionary meetings as a child with a neighbor, I was very much aware of the things they do at home and abroad. I made the commitment and I wholeheartedly try to uphold our Mission Statement.

What is required of you as a member of the ministry?

As a member of this Ministry, I feel I must be dedicated and committed. I must go beyond the call of duty to help others. I need to support my fellow sisters in the ministry and my church family.

What is your vision of the ministry in the next 5 years?

In five years, I hope that the membership has increased and that all the members tirelessly and unselfishly give of themselves. I hope we will have an outreach of projects to support the members, the church, the community, the state and foreign missions. I hope we stay the course supporting the YWA's (future senior missionaries).

The Senior Missionary Ministry prays that God will continue to keep us humble and in His care as we continue to serve this present age.

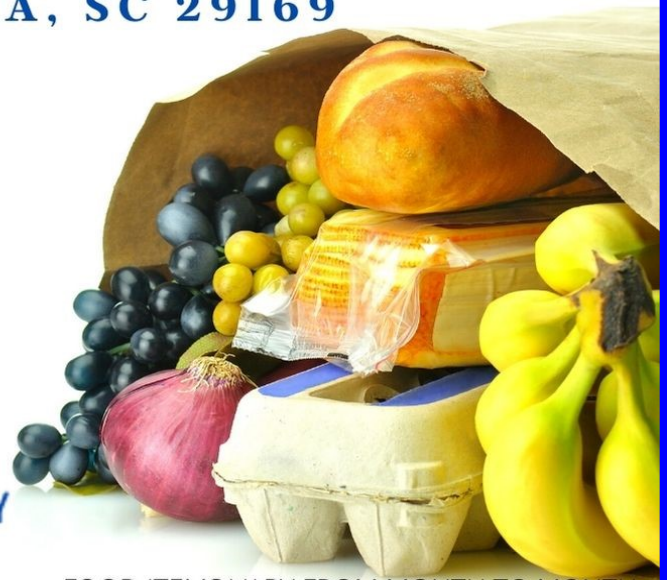

BLEC AND LRADAC FORM PARTNERSHIP TO ADDRESS A CRITICAL NEED

WEST COLUMBIA, S.C. --- Recognizing the potential power of combining resources to achieve a common goal, the Brookland-Lakeview Empowerment Center (BLEC) and the Lexington/Richland Alcohol and Drug Abuse Council (LRADAC) have established a partnership they hope will overcome the challenges to address a critical community need.



Through a separate grant awarded to both agencies, the goal of this unique collaboration is to offer mental health first aid trainings to empower families to help reduce the stigma of mental illness and alcohol and drug addiction. Each agency was awarded \$125,000 in funding per year over a five-year period to implement evidence-based mental health first aid trainings to the public aimed to reduce the stigma perceived for mental and behavioral health challenges. Both agencies seek to build an informed safety net of mental health first aid responders among the population.

"It makes sense to partner with LRADAC to provide these much-needed mental health first aid training services to the South Carolina community," said Dr. Cindye Richburg-Cotton, BLEC executive director. "Both agencies recognized the increase in mental health problems in our state. Mental health and substance abuse services are extraordinarily limited and underfunded in our state."
